FOREST CAMP, in just his second start, won the seven-furlong Del Mar Futurity (G2) by 5½ lengths over **DIXIE UNION**, **CAPTAIN STEVE** and **COMMENDABLE**, all of which are G1 winners themselves. His time, 1:21¾, resulted in a 106 Beyer, a phenomenal figure for a second-time starter. Next time out he finished 4½ lengths in front of champion **ANEES** in the Norfolk Stakes (G2). In his first start after a seven-month layoff at three, he took the sixfurlong Pirate's Bounty Stakes in 1:08¾, which translated to a 115 Beyer.

He's by **DEPUTY MINISTER**, whose sons at stud include **FRENCH DEPUTY** (like **FOREST CAMP** out of a Hold Your Peace mare), **DEHERE, TOUCH GOLD, AWESOME AGAIN** and **DEPUTY COMMANDER**.

His first crop yearlings sold for up to **\$450,000** at Fasig-Tipton July and averaged **\$128,778**. At Keeneland September seven of 10 yearlings offered in books 1-3 averaged **\$143,571**.
